Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

To be honest, I really used to dread summer Sundays at MVPC. With so many people going on vacations and many others on mission trips, the emptiness of our worship spaces was really depressing for me. I started feeling more positive the summer we got involved with Family Promise as we started talking about how so many of our biggest mission efforts happen in June and July—even if the pews are still a little bare on Sundays. This year with two weeks of Family Promise; four weeks of Los Niños Primero; a week of Vacation Bible School; and mission trips to Zambia, Honduras, and Memphis, summer is definitely not a slowdown. Our time and energy just are just more focused on some pretty impressive mission efforts.

Two years ago, summer surprisingly became my favorite season at MVPC. I was not exactly sure what would happen when I was outvoted by the Worship Planning Team to combine worship services at 10:00am. It turned out well enough to try it again last summer. We are still learning the best way to design this blended service, but it sure is nice having everyone in the same room together praising God, even if the differences between the combined service and the regular 9:00am and 11:00am services leave some feeling a little off balance. (Mostly me, I think.)

To help with that, here are some things to know regarding Sundays this summer:

- Worship will be at 10:00am! Maybe you guessed.
- Both the 9:00 and 11:00 music styles will be incorporated into each service.
- We will be using the new (purple) hymnal, which contains everything we use in the blue one plus new (to us) hymns I think you will like. Hymns (lyrics and music) will be projected because session wisely decided that \$8,000 was too much to refit the sanctuary with hymnals when the projectable version was only \$500. (And you sing louder when you are looking up.) We did purchase hymnals for the choir, though, and they will be made available to you in the narthex each Sunday if you prefer them.
- TJ has lined up weekly featured musicians, including our choir section leaders and some church members who play various instruments.
- TJ also found us an organist for the summer. Jill Hudson is an MVPS mom and a member/substitute organist at St. Luke Presbyterian. Please welcome her.
- Last summer I roped off the back pews so you would move forward, but the ropes proved easier to move than you! I give up. You sit where you want and I will preach from a lectern in front of the communion table.
- Communion will be served on the 1st and 3rd Sunday of each summer month.
- The church will not be providing food and beverages in the narthex this summer.
- NEXTSunday classes will be at 11:00am. (see p. 12-13)

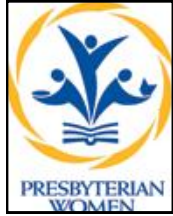

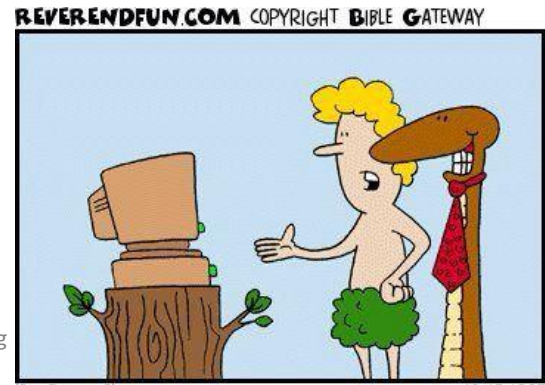
