Prayground: Our new **“Pray Ground”** is located in the area right of the pulpit with two tables and chairs set up for children and parents to use during the worship service. We would like this area to be limited to the resources in our worship packets and would appreciate it if parents would not bring toys from home. A favorite stuffed animal that provides security is perfectly fine. Parents or kids are invited to pick up a worship packet when they enter the sanctuary.

The area will be available to preschool and elementary age children. Parents (or grandparents) of preschool children should sit with their child when using this area. Elementary children can use the area alone or with a parent present. Mike Gillespie, our DCE, (or other volunteer) will also sit in that area to help children during worship.

Our **“Pray Ground”** can be accessed anytime during the service so parents and children should feel free to move to that area with a child during the service if necessary. Sitting up front near this area would make transition to the tables easier during the service.
