One Great Hour of Sharing: One of four annual offerings of the Presbyterian Church (USA), will be received on Easter Sunday, April 21. Each year, Presbyterians join with millions of other Christians to share God's love with people experiencing need. Our gifts support ministries of disaster response, refugee assistance and resettlement, and community development that help people find safe refuge, start new lives and work together to strengthen their families and communities. The Presbyterian Hunger Program receives 36 percent of undesignated gifts, while Self-Development of People and Presbyterian Disaster Assistance each receives 32 percent.
