Commissioning of this group of well-trained laypeople will be on Sunday. July 7. After that date, the Stephen Ministry is operational for referrals and will offer one on one, confidential care for individuals eighteen and older. They will be present during and after the traumatic event, during a long illness, as a companion to navigate a loss, a transition, or loneliness; a Stephen Minister will walk through it with you and you will not be alone.

All referrals go through the pastors.
