† Chalking the Door (see insert)

An old Epiphany tradition involves using chalk to write the letter CMB and the numbers of the current year, separated by crosses (+), over the doors of congregations and Christian homes: 20 + C + M + B + 20. The letters CMB are said to stand for the names of the magi (Casper, Melchior, and Balthazar) or the Latin phrase Christus mansionem benedicat (Christ bless this house).
