Participation and Collaboration: Christian Education at MVPC

Often colleagues to congregants and even complete strangers share that they notice people do not join a church because of the denomination any longer, rather they join (or get involved) because of how "relevant" the church is to their lives. This is no different at MVPC. Many come to our church because they are drawn to the various programs of our Christian Education ministry. This Ministry Team, overseen by our Associate Pastor, Rev. Isaac Toney-Schmitt, offers community and spaces for people to gather- from the youngest to the eldest and everyone in between.

Recently, I spoke with Isaac and asked what is happening with Christian Education and how you can support or connect with some of the ministries under its purview:

Children's Ministry: Thanks to the wonderful leadership of Carrie Southard and others, each Sunday we offer Sunday school for children during the back half of worship. Many of you are already familiar with this ministry, but as we head into the summer and you may have grandchildren coming in, have them join the other children for a time of teaching, storytelling, and fun. Also, make note that August 13-14 (Saturday-Sunday) we will hold Back to School Bible School (think VBS right before school starts) along with a special worship service that Sunday.





Summary of Session Meeting May 15, 2022

The Session met for its regular monthly meeting and the following business was conducted:

- · John Allen, President of the Mount Vernon Presbyterian Church Foundation attended and gave a report regarding grants the Foundation gives each year to grant applicants. Applicants are generally MVPC outreach partners such as Clifton Ministries, Family Promise, and the Community Assistance Center. John announced that a church member will match up to \$21,000 given to the Foundation and is encouraging everyone to give so this money can be matched.
- The Witness Ministry Team encourages people to use Sign-Up Genius to take their turn in providing refreshments for Connections, the 10:00 to 10:25 period just before the worship service. Refreshments are simple and instructions are provided on the Sign-up Genius webpage. Witness is also looking for volunteers to take their turn as Greeters during the Connections time. People willing to do this should contact Robbie Hawthorne or the church office.

The Outreach Ministry Team is planning a recognition for volunteers during the Pentecost Sunday (June 5) worship service and plans to recognize all who have served as church volunteers in various ways over the past year. Volunteers include those who have served on ministry teams, help with Family Promise, worked in the church office, and in many other ways of serving the church.

- The Christian Education team reminds everyone that Sunday School will continue through the summer. A modified Vacation Bible School will be offered as a weekend event and is tentatively scheduled for August 13-14.
- The Finance and Administration team is thankful for continued strong giving by members. Offerings through April have us within budget projections for the year. Work on the Sanctuary Building HVAC system is still in the planning stages and will involve a lengthy process of replacing the unit that is the original HVAC unit.
- · A special offering was approved for the ministries MVPC supports in Zambia. Barbara Hughes will be going there later this year and will take the offering. Purchases will be made there in Lusaka which will support local businesses there as well as eliminate shipping costs.
- · Members who have moved their membership to other churches were removed from the rolls.

A report was given regarding business that was conducted at the May 3 Presbytery Meeting. Outgoing Presbytery Clerk Donna Wells was recognized. The Nominating Committee presented its recommendation for the new clerk, Rev. Andy James, who was then elected by the Commissioners.

The Session will not meet in June. The next Stated Session Meeting will be July 17.
