#### A Letter From The Pastor

What's Happening with Our Youth?

Last month, I had the opportunity to join with our youth in Gailey Hall as we volunteered for the Sandy Springs Education Force. This is a new partnership to help local students and their families get access to supplies and books. Our job that Sunday evening was to organize these materials. What I loved about this opportunity is that it was a glimpse of what our youth and our church embodies in this moment. We had people of all ages and abilities gathered, and our youth welcomed them into "their" space and together we lived into the image of the Mount Vernon community. Later, I would ask youth members Ben Barber and Kyle Cumming to name one thing

Rev. Isaac Toney-Schmitt has taught them and they replied, "He is a welcoming, open guy. He talks to everyone the same. He leads by example and connects everything to God." This example was carried out by our youth that night.

In addition to continuing this monthly mission work with the Sandy Springs Education Force, the youth have a big November planned. During the first weekend, Isaac will be leading middle school youth like Samantha Fifield down to Camp Calvin for a retreat with other area Presbyterian Churches. They will draw on Matthew 25- "the least of these"- as they connect to God through worship, workshops, and fellowship. The following weekend our high school youth will enjoy a two-night camping trip in the north Georgia mountains with Isaac.

Eight years ago we established the Zambia College Scholarship fund for deserving students. These students must have successfully completed high school, be very bright, motivated and demonstrate extreme financial need. # THE ZAMBIAN COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM



### Education: A way out of Poverty.

The Zambian College Scholarship Fund was established eight years ago out of a desire to help vulnerable students who have graduated from high school in Zambia obtain a college education. The scholarship program gives priority for enrollment to orphans and materially deprived students. So far, fourteen students have graduated through this program with five more graduating in 2023.

We aim to sponsor twelve students total in 2023, by adding three students to our current roster of nine. There is no way for us to truly understand the difference education can make in the lives of these students. You are helping to make dreams a reality!

Francis is pursuing a degree in Computer Technology and will graduate at the end of 2023 after finishing his school work towards this end. He says that before this scholarship program, he was unable to really concentrate on his work as he was constantly worried about paying for school and how that would happen. I believe education will help my family from lacking basic needs.

He says that this year has been hard but, "I have hope and happiness because you and I both are convinced that our Creator Almighty is and will be with us as long as we remain in faith and hopeful in Him who created us and gives us life each and every day!"







# **Summary of Session Meeting**

#### Stated Session Meeting October 16, 2022

Following is a summary of that meeting:

- Representatives of the Presbytery's
   Committee on Preparation for the
   Ministry (CPM) met with the Session
   to provide training in how the Session
   should support pastoral Inquirers and
   Candidates. Part of the work of the
   Session is to educate the congregation
   on the identification, preparation, and
   support of those who feel called to the
   ministry.
- Shari Freeman wishes to enter the Inquirer phase (the first phase of answering the call to ministry; this phase is followed by candidacy phase, and the ordination phase). The Session interviewed Shari and following a time of Q & A, voted unanimously to support her in the Inquirer, Candidacy, and Ordination processes.

- Beppie Lever has been asked to be the MVPC liaison who will work directly with Shari Freeman and CPM.
- The Finance and Administration
   Ministry Team reported that giving
   continues to be on track to fund this
   year's budget but reminded the
   Session that this is a deficit budget.
- The Outreach MT reported that we have exceeded our goal for funding the Garden School in Zambia.
- The Senior Program has had such a strong response to the north Georgia trip on Oct. 22, a bus has been secured to take the group to see the fall colors in the mountains.

The next Stated Session Meeting will be November 20.
