This Kirk is catholic, that is, universal, because it contains the chosen of all ages, of all realms, nations, and tongues, be they of the Jews or be they of the Gentiles, who have communion and society with God the Father, and with the Son, Christ Jesus, through the sanctification of the Holy Spirit.

The word "Kirk" is Gaelic for church. As we return to our church building, may we be inspired by this confession to live out the expansive vision of the **Triune God** found in these words.
