The apostle Simon Peter was among the first disciples chosen by Jesus and the first to recognize Jesus as Messiah. The crossed keys on his shield represent Peter as holder of the keys to the Kingdom of Heaven. Peter preached in many places, eventually coming to Rome, and it is believed he formed the first Christian community there. He was arrested and imprisoned, sentenced to die. He requested crucifixion head down, for he did not feel himself worthy to die in the same manner as his Lord had died.

Samuel John Stone wrote these lyrics in response to a schism within the church of South Africa. John Colenso, the Bishop of Natal, denounced the Bible as untrue. Stone became involved in this debate and wrote a set of hymns in response, hence the highlighted line in the 3rd verse.

God of Forgiveness, we need your forgiveness just as Simon Peter needed your forgiveness. Like us, Simon Peter often said the right things, declared that you are the Messiah, and stepped up to be the leader who holds the keys to the Kingdom of Heaven. Simon Peter knew you as God, yet he would still go on to deny knowing you at your crucifixion. Like us, Simon Peter is up to the task of the call to be your disciple. And, like us, Simon Peter needs your forgiveness to continue being your disciple. Hear the urgency to be near you in our confession, forgive us, and bring us into your loving presence ...
