John, son of Zebedee and brother of the apostle James, is called the disciple whom Jesus loved. The eagle wing soaring upward from the chalice symbolizes his divine inspiration for the writings attributed to him: the Gospel of John, the three Epistles, and the Revelation. The seven crosses on the chalice represent the seven churches in Asia Minor mentioned in the Revelation. The chalice symbolizes the persecution that John and many other Christians suffered at the hands of Emperor Domitian, who, according to legend, ordered John to drink a cup of poisoned wine. In spite of many attempts on his life, John is said to be the only apostle who died a natural death at an advanced age.

ONE: What do you believe concerning "the holy catholic church"?

ALL: I believe that the Son of God through his Spirit and Word, out of the entire human race, from the beginning of the world to its end, gathers, protects, and preserves for himself, a community chosen for eternal life and united in true faith. And of this community I am and always will be a living member.

ONE: What do you understand by "the communion of saints"?

ALL: First, that believers one and all, as members of this community, share in Christ and in all his treasures and gifts. Second, that each member should consider it a duty to use these gifts readily and joyfully for the service and enrichment of the other members.

Written in Germany in 1563, the Heidelberg Catechism was brought to the North American colonies in 1609, making it the first Reformed confession in North America.
